1. Share the different ways that the English language uses the word “love”?
2. What do we mean when we say “fall in love”? How is this different from the love for a parent, spouse, or friend? How are these two types of love experienced differently?
3. How has your understanding of romantic love and unconditional (agape) love changed over the years?
4. What is perfect love? Is it different coming from God than coming from people?
5. If love is a verb more than a noun, share the most extraordinary act of love you have ever witnessed or received.
6. Boundaries in a relationship are important. How do we balance loving people with boundaries? Give some examples of what this looks like.
7. Read together 1 Corinthians 13 two times. In the first reading, identify who in your family and how you need practice this type of love toward (spouse, best friend, sibling)?
8. In the second reading, identify who outside of your family do you need to show this type of love to (a colleague, family member, neighbor, business partner, ex)?
