- 1. How would you define God's will? Is it different for an individual versus a group of people?
- 2. Does God always have a desired course of action for an individual? A group of people?
- 3. Can we always know God's will?
- 4. Recount a time in your life when you felt totally confused as to what God wanted you to do. What was the outcome?
- 5. Talk about a time when God was clearly directing you? What made it obvious?
- 6. Describe a time when you followed God's will down a path that seemed to make no sense or was counter to what people would tell you to do. How did it turn out and how were you changed through it?
- 7. What advice have you heard about figuring out God's will? What has been the best resource you've found to discern God's will?
- 8. Think about someone who couldn't hear God speak because their own habits or actions were drowning out what God was directing. What was getting in their way?
- 9. Do you believe you are completely following God's will right now?
 - a. What can you do to ensure you continue in His will?
 - b. What may you need to change to better hear His will?

ACTION STEP

Spend 5 minutes individually writing down areas of your life where you want God's direction. Then write down any sin or distraction in your life that may be getting in the way. Partner up with one other person in the group and spend no more than 2 minutes each praying over these.
