

## **"Choose The Messiah" –Core 12**

### ***Psalm 110:1-7***

Psalm 110 is Messianic Prophecy and is quoted in NT more than any other OT scripture.

#### **A. Jesus the LORD...**

***"The LORD says to my Lord: 'Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool.'" Psalm 110:1***

- David is not talking about Himself...
  - Matt 22:42 (to Pharisees) - But what about you? Who do you say Jesus is? "The son of David", they replied. How is it that David, speaking by the spirit, calls himself Lord?
  - LORD: Yahweh (Hebrew) – Father God
  - Lord: Adonai – Son, Christ, Messiah, anointed one, coming Deliverer
1. Jesus is divine.
  2. Jesus is the Son of God.
    - a. Matt 16:15-16 – Peter who do you say I am? You are the Christ!!!!
  3. Jesus has authority, power and control.

#### **B. Jesus the King...**

***"The LORD will extend Your mighty scepter from Zion, saying, 'Rule in the midst of Your enemies!' Your troops will be willing on Your day of battle." Psalm 110:2-3a***

1. Jesus is a descendant of King David.
2. Jesus is a leader people naturally follow.
3. Jesus did not deny being a king.

#### **C. Jesus the Priest...**

***"The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind: 'You are a priest forever in the order of Melchizedek.'" Psalm 110:4***

1. Jesus is a priest in the order of Melchizedek.
  - a. Priest is mediator for people
  - b. Gen 14:18 king of Salem and priest during Abrahams time

2. Jesus is the perfect high priest and mediator!
  - a. 1 Tim 2:5 *For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,*
3. Jesus is the perfect sacrifice.
  - a. Lamb of God
  - b. Romans 7 Jesus is holy blameless and the perfect sacrifice

#### **D. Jesus the Judge...**

***"He will judge the nations, heaping up the dead and crushing the rulers of the whole earth." Psalm 110:6***

1. Jesus has the responsibility of judgment. J
  - i. John 5:27 And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.
2. Jesus will separate the sheep and the goats.
  - i. Matt 25:31 31"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne. 32All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. 33He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. 34"Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.
3. Jesus will judge the world after His second coming.
  - i. Mark 13 – No one knows the time or place!

1. What about you? Who do you say Jesus is?
