

## **THE NEW COVENANT**

### **“Jesus and Moses” –Core (Deut 18:18)**

#### **A. Moses was a shadow of Jesus...Heb 10:1**

1. Both Moses and Jesus were saved in Egypt.
2. Both survived testing through water.
3. Jesus’ five major sermons mirrored the Torah.
4. Both Moses and Jesus had a conversation on top of a mountain during the transfiguration.
5. Jesus’ Last Supper was during the Passover
6. Both were liberators, lawgivers, and shepherds. Pg 40, Core52

#### **B. Moses brought redemption to people...Exo 6:6**

1. God called Moses at the burning bush to be the savior of His people. Exodus 3:2-3
2. After the plagues in Egypt, Moses instituted the Passover, a symbol of redemption. Exodus 12:13
3. Moses led the people out of Egypt through the Red Sea. Exodus 14:21
4. Moses received instructions for worship and the Ten Commandments. Exodus 34:28
5. Moses led his people through the wilderness to the Promised Land. Levi 20:24

#### **C. God’s love came through Jesus...John 1:17**

1. Jesus was the one the prophets predicted. John 1:45
2. Just as Moses lifted up a pole, so Jesus

would be lifted up on the cross. John 3:14-15

3. Jesus was the Bread of life. John 6:32

4. Just as Moses had the veil covering his face, their hearts were veiled, and they did not understand. But Jesus took the veil away! 2 Cor 3:15-18

#### **D. Jesus fulfilled all that Moses brought to the people...Jeremiah 31:31-33**

1. Jesus wants to be Bread of life to us! Are you willing to let Jesus be the most essential part of your life and the gift of eternal life? John 6:35
2. Jesus wants to be our deliverer. He will rescue you! Are you willing to trust Him for deliverance in your life? 2 Corinthians 1:10
3. Jesus wants you to see clearly the truth of life. Are you willing to believe that Christ can give you the truth and not the world’s sources? 2 Corinthians 3:14
4. The Holy Spirit will now be your guide. Will you surrender to His guidance and not your own? John 16:13
5. Jesus wants to be your Savior! Are you willing to trust Him with your life? Acts 4:12
