  - a. *King David was born in Bethlehem (1 Sam. 16:18). Jesus was born in Bethlehem (Luke 2:4-7).*
  - b. *David was appointed king by God (1 Sam. 6:1). Jesus was born King and sent by God the Father (Matt. 2:2, Acts 2:34-36).*
  - c. *David was a shepherd and became king (1 Sam. 16:11). Jesus*

*came as both King and Shepherd (John 10:11).*

- d. *David refused to be made king before God’s time*
- e. *(1 Sam. 24:4-7, 18, 26:8-9). Jesus refused to reign as King before God’s time (John 6:15).*
- f. *David brought peace and security to physical Israel*
- g. *(2 Sam. 8:6, 14, 1 Chron. 8:6). Jesus brought peace and security to spiritual Israel (Rom. 5:1, Eph. 2:14-15).*
- h. *David was a king with whom God was well pleased (1 Sam. 13:14). Jesus is the King with whom God is well pleased (Matt. 13:17).*
- i. *David gathered the low and despised into his kingdom (1 Sam. 22:1-2). Jesus gathers the low and despised into His kingdom (1 Cor. 1:27-28).*
- j. *When the enemy pursues David, few of his people follow him (2 Sam. 15:14). When Jesus was taken, his friends scattered (Matt. 26:56).*
- k. *David was 30 years old when he became king (2 Sam. 5:4). Jesus began His public ministry at 30 years of age (Luke 2:23).*
- l. *David reigned from Jerusalem over all Israel for 33 years (2 Sam. 5:5). Jesus was King from birth (Matt. 2:2), and lived for 33 years.*
