“A New Calling” –Core 5
Leviticus 11:45 ESV

A. The Holy Spirit begins His work...(John 3:3)

1. When you are born again, the Holy Spirit comes to live in your life. (Acts 2:38)
2. The Holy Spirit is a person and He comes to live in us as the third person of the Trinity. (John 16:13-14)
3. The work of holiness begins when He begins to live in us. We are set apart for God’s use. (2 Corinthians 7:1)
4. Holiness is the natural process of becoming more like Jesus. (2 Corinthians 3:17-18)
5. The work of holiness continues to grow as we continue to make choices of surrender. (Romans 6:22)
6. The new life we choose, is the life God chose for us! (1Peter 1:23)

B. God chooses us to be holy... (1 Peter 1:15-16)

1. God chooses us as His people to be holy. (1 Peter 2:9)
2. God chose us from the beginning of the world. (Ephesians 1:3-5)
3. God chose us to be His and to bear fruit. (John 15:16)
4. God chose us to make us holy while believing. (2 Thessalonians 2:13)

C. You are holy because...

1. God makes us holy.(1 Thessalonians 5:23)
2. God empowers us to live a holy life. (2 Peter 1:3-4)
3. God works in us as we work at choosing holiness. (Hebrews 12:14)
4. Holiness is the destination of our journey. (1 Timonty 1:9)

D. The image of God was marred by sin... (Romans 5:12,18)

1. We were created in the image of God to be holy. (Romans 8:29)
2. God through Christ gives us a new opportunity to be holy. (Ephesians 4:24)
3. It is God’s will for us to be holy. (Hebrews 10:10)
4. When we are wholly God’s, we are holy. (Romans 12:1)
5. God will keep us holy! (1 Corinthians 1:8)
6. God will bring you through and keep you holy! (Jude 1:24)
7. It is no longer me, but Christ who lives in me. (Galatians 2:20)
