1. Read Ephesians 2. Like the previous lesson, pretend you've never experienced church and that what you read in Ephesians 2 is your first and only exposure to the characteristics of church. What conclusions or assumptions would you make about church?
2. Read Ephesians 2:10. Is this a promise for the church or for each individual believer?
3. What are the stewardship implications to each person being a masterpiece of God with a unique set of good deeds to accomplish?
4. What, in particular, about the passage convicted you personally about something in your life and leadership?
5. Is this a shift that is worth the effort to pursue and to see put in place? How important is it to you? Why or why not?
6. In five years from now, if you were mobilizing God's people, God's way with an approach that was rooted in "more masterpieces" rather than "more volunteers," what would that look like?
7. What would the characteristics of success be? What benefits? Create a list of characteristics that collectively describes a preferable future.
8. Are there actions you already know you'd need to take that can be identified now?
